He has performed and recorded with many great jazz and pop legends, including Phil Woods, the National Jazz Ensemble, and Tony Bennett, to name just a few. He has also participated in three best of the year "Grammy Group" awards in 1977, 1982, and 1983 as part of the Phil Woods Quartet.

Jimmy Ward is a veteran musician who has performed with rock group Blood, Sweat & Tears and Stephen Stills. Ward began studying piano at age seven, but soon switched to guitar. He studied music at the University of Florida, but gave up his studies and went out on the road.
