The new meeting time will be every second Wednesday evening of the month at 5:30 pm in the Bay County Public Library Meeting Room. This month's read is *Hidden Figures: The American Dream and the Untold Story of the Black Women Mathematicians Who Helped Win the Space Race* by Margot Lee Shetterly and meets on June 14<sup>th</sup>. The History Book Club focuses on both historical fiction and non-fiction titles.
